

Desktop Publishing/Graphic Design Degree 2012 CATALOG CHECK LIST - AAS.DPGD (028)

Helpful hints: Pay attention to Pre-requisites! Be aware that some courses are ONLY offered during certain semesters. Keep your old class schedules (typically if a course was offered this spring, it will also be offered next spring, etc.). Plan at least 2 semesters in advance (especially when you get close to finishing up). Get cleared to Register by your advisor ASAP & register the FIRST day you can before classes you need fill up. Be aware that your faculty advisor is NOT available to help you during school breaks. Take specialized BUS & CIS courses FIRST and then fill in your schedule with general education requirements. Cut down on Spring and Fall semester hours by taking 1 or 2 general education courses in the summer (note: specialized BUS & CIS courses are typically NOT offered during summer, but SOC, ENG, SFS, etc. are).
